



It's important for us that participants follow our rules. If you get selected, we will ask you to sign them.
























The origins of E4E

In 1951, six countries (Belgium, Germany, France, Italy, Luxembourg and the Netherlands) founded the European Coal and Steel Community. In 1958 it became known as the European Economic Community (EEC). In 1993 the name was changed to European Union. In 2006, six Rotary clubs from the founding countries of the EU came up with the idea to offer young people from the EU member

states the opportunity to get to know the six founding countries better by experiencing the culture and cities together.
