

The Route	Important notes
The route is a single lap of approximately 5.5 miles	Help us keep the beach and nature reserve clean – please do not drop litter
There will be 42 marshals and direction signage along the route.	The beach will be open to other users
There will be tailrunner behind the final runner	Please do not wear headphones as you may not hear warnings from marshals
• The route follows a sandy path behind the dunes towards Burnham Over Staithe	Be careful on the route – it is uneven in places
• The route turns right at the Coastal Path and crosses the dunes onto the beach.	If you feel unwell or get injured – please let a marshal know
Once on the beach the route turns right and runs parallel with the sea	If you see a runner that is injured, please let the next marshal know
<ul> <li>There is a water crossing at four miles – the race is at low tide so this will be shallow (around five centimetres deep) there will be two marshals here</li> </ul>	The race has a Trail Runners Association licence and will comply with TRA rules
The route then turns right around the dunes and heads to the finish	We must comply with TRA rules, so no dogs or buggies are allowed
