





## **ROTOS Network Survey**

- A wide range of research areas were mentioned by respondents








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Highest level of education

# Expectations of the ROTOS Network

What are you expecting joining the ROTOS NETWORK? (E.g.: services, meetings, assistance, networking of researchers, guidelines, information about grants....)

- The most frequent response was 'Networking' or 'Network' with 27/53 people mentioning this in their responses
- Respondents also frequently mentioned 'connecting' 'connections' and 'meetings'
- Respondents sought a space to discuss research ideas, share their research, and form research collaborations
- A few respondents joined the ROTOS Network 'for inspiration'
- A few respondents mentioned receiving information and/or support with research grants
- A few respondents were seeking information about research opportunities, guidelines, research post vacancies



To facilitate this, ROTOS is developing the **Research Interest Groups (RIGs)**, designed to connect OT and OS professionals who share common research interests









## What Are RIGs?

RIGs are going to be specialised groups led by dedicated researchers who volunteer their time to guide and organise the group's activities. Each RIG will focus on a specific topic within OT and/or OS, providing a platform for members to:

- Inspire and learn from each other
- Share their work and current research projects
- Collaborate on new research pathways and initiatives
- Collaborate on research projects and grant applications
- Discuss relevant articles and research
- Provide possibilities for mentoring
