Home team treatment room/First aid room – towards the back of Royston FC dressing room or on the left-hand side before entering the clubhouse

Locations of medical equipment are as follows:

Defibrillator – Home dugout and behind the bar in the clubhouse Oxygen/Entonox – Home dugout Stifneck Collar (C-spine) – Home dugout Frac-Immobiliser/Vacuum Splint – Home dugout Spinal board with head immobiliser – Inside home treatment room Stretcher – In the tunnel, outside of the home dressing room

Please hold your arm in an "X" sign towards the home dugout for medical assistance on the pitch

If a player is to be stretched from the field of play, they can be taken into the home team treatment room and monitored by their **OWN** team therapist. This is accessed by walking up the tunnel and turning right through the gate. Full support will be provided via Royston FC staff to assist.
