These are 4 possible reactions we can get when we share the Gospel:

Red light

The person rejects the Gospel and shows no positive reaction. In this case we bless the person, explain that we had not intended to aggravate him/her but to share something good from God instead. We move on and continue searching for persons of peace.

Yellow light

The person shows interest but is not ready to embrace the Gospel. Perhaps the person needs time to digest your message and to research on his own. We don't push nor force people to pray a prayer nor to rush into a decision. In those cases, we offer prayer and share one of the 7 Stories of Hope right there. If the person has no time, it's a good idea to exchange telephone numbers and fix a time for a coffee within the next 48 hours. A yellow light often becomes a green light. There might be many yellow lights in your Oikos map.

Green light

The person is touched by Jesus, repents and asks how to have a new life. In this case we ask the Holy Spirit to lead us in order to baptise the person and to train him/her on the 411. Then we make an appointment to start going through the foundations.

Already believer

If the person is already a believer, we rejoice we found one and we ask the person how he/she got saved. His/her testimony will help us understand the person better. Then we offer the person to meet up again in order to share the 411 tool. If there is interest, we continue to meet to bring the person through the foundations.
