It will enhance the uptake of operational climate services in three carefully selected rural/semi-rural regions across Africa, identifying and expediting adaptation and resilience in these regions.

Climate services and adaptation measures can help prevent negative climate risks by ensuring that communities are better equipped to cope with the impacts of climate change, such as drought, floods, and other extreme weather events, while ensuring that activities are aligned with national policies.

Our specific objectives will be:

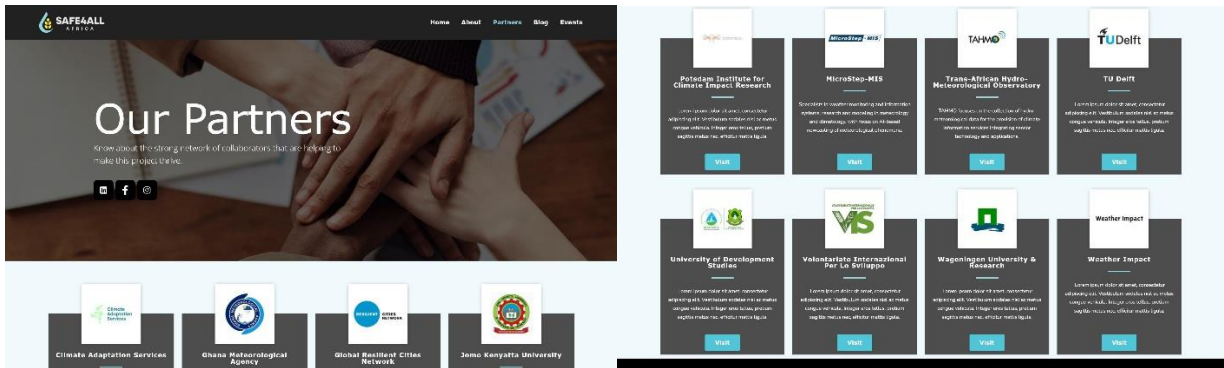
- Establish a collaborative, co-creation and engagement platform** for the provision and co-development of needed-based climate information services to tackle issues related to migration, food security and climate resilience within rural urban continuum in sub-Saharan Africa.
- Identify adaptation challenges, requirements, enabling and hindering factors in adapting** to the water access, economic environment, while ensuring alignment with policy goals such as safeguarding biodiversity, boosting agribusiness and digitalisation, ensuring riparian that can be more self-reliant and resilient to climate change.
- Explore and harness existing climate services and develop new suite of user-centred state-of-the-art climate services (for foodsheds, hydro-meteorological disaster and ecosystem management)** that can be linked together (cross-sectoral) leveraging opportunities with digital innovation including artificial intelligence, big data and remote sensing to improve the quality of climate information and provide a more efficient service delivery at local and regional levels.
- Tailor the services and tools in GIZ to local policy contexts** for each SAFE4ALL country and support to integrate all the services with the local adaptation processes and communication patterns using storytelling maps to create actionable and inspiring outputs for climate adaptation to boost the attainment of the SDGs.
- Recommend and implement sustainable business models** for the services developed in the countries (GIZ spaces). In the SAFE4ALL countries, some joint-venture models are available. In addition, the project also explores the potential services and revenue.
- Foster multi- and interdisciplinary links and collaborations** through use of a transnational and Africa-oriented multi-disciplinary team of researchers and a program to facilitate the attainment of SDGs.



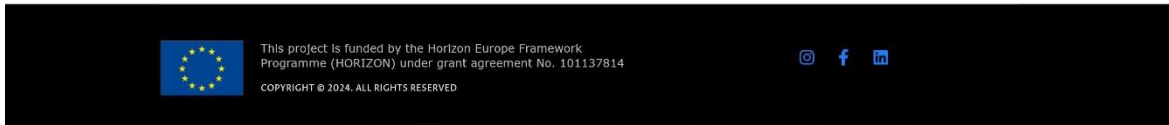
