SALC will cover E. Dabrowska's expenses (around 11.000 SEK). We may not be in the position to give stipends to students this year, and we will therefore add the condition that student stipends will be offered if the financial situation permits. The committee for student stipends will be Marlene (chair) and Esa. Kristian will contact De Gruyter/Benjamins and ask if they would be interested in sponsoring e.g. a wine reception or books for the winner of the best presentation award. The SALC7 organizers have so far received four proposals for theme sessions. Each theme session can have 2 to 9 talks. They have also received two suggestions for satellite events.
- 8. Next conference
 If we follow the current tradition that the four member countries take turns to
 organize the conference, the next conference should be in Finland. Esa will start
 looking for possible hosts in Finland.
- 9. Next meeting
 The next board meeting will be in January 2019
