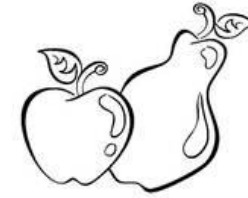
FLOWER CLASSES

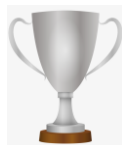
PRESERVES CLASSES

SHOW RULES

- All entry fees must be paid at the time of staging; entry fee is 50p per entry up to a maximum of £5, further entries free.
- Exhibitors may enter a maximum of 3 exhibits per class. Except classes 19 & 20.
- **Doors open at 11am. All exhibits must be staged before 1:00pm on Saturday 9th September. Exhibitors must exit hall by 1:00 or soon after** for judging to begin.
- **Exhibitors will be readmitted at 2:30pm** to view the prize certificates and rosettes. There are no cash prizes.
- The judges' decision is final.
- All entries are at owners' risk.
- Produce must be grown or made in the exhibitor's private garden, allotment or kitchen.



The Samwaies Cup is awarded annually to the family with the **most points in the show** from any classes. 3 points for first prize, 2 points for second prize, 1 point for third prize.

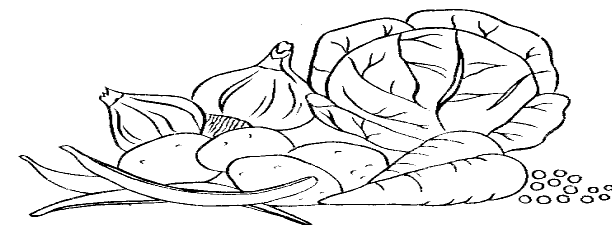
