SHOW RULES

- Exhibitors in the junior classes must be no older than 14 years 364 days on 31st August 2023.
- All entry fees must be paid at the time of staging; entry fee for the junior classes is 50p per entry up to 6 entries, further entries are free.
- Juniors may exhibit in the adult classes if they wish. Entry fee for adult classes is 50p per class up to 10 entries and free thereafter.
- All exhibits must be staged before 1:00pm on Saturday 9th September. **Exhibitors must exit hall by 1:0pm or soon after** for judging to begin.
- **Exhibitors will be allowed back into the hall at 2:30pm** to view the prize certificates. There are no cash prizes. The judges' decision is final.
- All entries are at owners' risk.
- Produce must be grown or made in the exhibitor's private garden, allotment or kitchen.
- All exhibits must be the child's own work with only adult intervention to ensure child's safety.
