Trade Need to Know licenses & Insurance

Your legal and social responsibilities...



A Trade Licence (plate) is:

- Issued by Driver Vehicle Licence Agency (DVLA)
- Displayed front & rear on the vehicle
- Instead of registration number and/or road tax
- Issued to qualifying motor traders & vehicle testers
- For temporarily owned vehicles in course of your business i.e. valeting, repair, fitting or scrapping
- Restricted to **50mph** (max)

Advice on home maintenance businesses apply to local Trading Standards Office

It is not:

For carrying passengers or goods unless in course of your business

ABC 123

An exemption for MOT or Insurance (exceptions apply)



Trade Insurance:

- Is for car dealers, mechanics, tuners and valets
- Requires the driver to know cover is in place for time & purpose
- May not cover anyone to drive any vehicle unless stated

Fine £5,000 (max) Prison 2 years (max)
