

ACCEPTANCE ADDRESS BY HIS EXCELLENCY DR JULIUS MAADA BIO, PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SIERRA LEONE, FOLLOWING THE OATH OF OFFICE AS PRESIDENT-ELECT IN THE 2023 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS FREETOWN, SIERRA LEONE TUESDAY, JUNE 27th, 2023

- 1. I am extremely humbled and immensely thankful for the trust and confidence you have placed in me with your overwhelming vote — securing me and the Sierra Leone People's Party (SLPP) victory to lead our great nation, Sierra Leone, for another term of five years.
- 2. With this second-term mandate, you have proven, beyond every reasonable doubt, your abiding faith in my capacity to sustain and advance the transformational work that we began in 2018.
- 3. For this, I must thank the Almighty God for his abundant mercies and blessings that have brought us thus far.

- 9. In that spirit, we traversed the length and breadth of our country to give account of our stewardship over the last five years and share our national development plan for the next five years. This rigorous campaign culminated in the victory we are marking today.
- 10. The focus of my next Government shall be Food Security, consolidating gains in Human Capital Development, creating jobs for our youth, revamping the Public Service and developing technology and infrastructure.

- 11. This victory wouldn't have been possible without the active support of our SLPP leadership, loyal party members, campaign management team, trusted confidants, volunteers, stakeholders and the Progressive Alliance Members.

- 15. Fellow Sierra Leoneans, I am always committed to being a fair leader and the President for all. Regardless of your political affiliation, tribe, religion, or socioeconomic background, I dedicate myself to serving you with dedication, integrity, and commitment. Our victory today is not just mine; it belongs to every Sierra Leonean

who dreams of a brighter and better future for our nation.

- 16. I, therefore, extend a hand of fellowship to my brother and foremost opposition leader, Dr Samura Kamara of the All People's Congress (APC), to join us in the arduous task of nation-building. The job ahead is enormous, but collectively, we can build the country of our dreams the Sierra Leone our current and future generations deserve.
- 17. It is time for us to join hands in blurring the lines drawn during the spirited campaign season and reunite as one united family proud members of the Sierra Leonean nation.

- 18. We are all united in our love for Sierra Leone. If we falter, our country will suffer. Conversely, if we succeed, our collective prosperity flourishes. Today, I humbly seek the support and collaboration of all our citizens in forging ahead to build a prosperous Sierra Leone.
- 19. I want to continue admonishing all Sierra Leoneans to be peaceful and law-abiding. In particular, I ask my supporters to be exemplary in being peaceful and magnanimous in victory. We ran a peaceful, principled and progressive campaign. Therefore, we must remain peaceful, law-abiding and embrace our brothers and sisters on opposite sides to join our efforts to build Mama Salone.

- 20. We commend the Electoral Commission for Sierra Leone (ECSL) for conducting a free, fair, transparent and credible election. With each election cycle, we have increasingly improved on the process as it is vital to our democratic ideals.
- 21. Finally, I thank the local and International Observer Missions, the media, and our development partners for holding our country to higher standards and ensuring that these elections stand the test of international best practices and global scrutiny.
- 22. Fellow Sierra Leoneans, thank you again for your unwavering and enthusiastic support and the opportunity to serve our great nation at the highest office of the land.
