Materiality Matters: New Approaches to Medieval Sealing Cultures, Justus-Liebig-Universität Gießen, 14-15 September 2015

This recent workshop in Germany marked the close of an interdisciplinary research project on the fingerprints made deliberately on the many surviving impressions of Speyer's city seal. It brought together scholars from across Europe who have been concerned with the materiality of seals: the materials from which they were made, and the ways in which they have been treated cared for and examined over time.

# Empreintes du passé: Rouen et Jumièges, 11 September-5 December 2015

Presented by the department of Seine-Maritime Departmental Archives, in collaboration with the Departmental Museum of Antiquities in Rouen and Jumièges Abbey scientific Curators: Michael Bloche and Caroline Dorion-Peyronnet, this exhibition has run across three sites:

- Aux origines du sceau Musée départemental des Antiquités 198, rue Beauvoisine -76000 Rouen
- 1,000 ans de sceaux en Seine-Maritime Archives départementales de la Seine-Maritime (site de Grammont) Pôle culturel Grammont – 42, rue Henri II- Plantagenêt, 76100 Rouen
- Images de cire Abbaye de Jumièges 24, rue Guillaume le Conquérant 76480 Jumièges

This exhibition should be an opportunity to make known to the general public the considerable work conducted in recent years by the Archives department of Seine-Maritime and the sigillographic collections of the Museum of Antiquities. At the

Museum, Mesopotamian seals, Egyptian and Gallo-Roman will be on display; while in the Archives, the focus will be on medieval seals as exceptional testimony of their time. The objective is also to enhance the same setting of the Abbey of Jumièges with nearly 1600 original impressions in wax, from the twelfth century to the French Revolution. This will be the first time since the French Revolution that charters of the abbey return to Jumièges.

A programme of talks accompanies the exhibitions.
