- Each poem must be on a separate A4 sheet and 2 copies of each poem must be submitted
- All entries must be received by the Competition Secretary no later than 15th May 2017.
- Name of the competitor & title(s) of poem(s) must be listed on the Entry Form
 or a cover sheet to which a cheque for the total entry fee must be attached.
- Correct postage must be paid to avoid disqualification and forfeiture of your entry fee.
- The copyright of all poems remains with the author. Authors of cash winning poems only agree to allow inclusion of their poems on the Slipstream web site in the 2017 Competition Results Section. Any 'Commended' poems and their authors will be posted only by name.

The author of the 1st Prize will also be awarded The Jim Johnston Chanctonbury Cup to be held for a period of one year. Venue, time and place will be notified and other prize winners and authors of any commended poems, will be invited to read their work.
