Her most recent publication (2017) is *Ladders of Glass* – a pamphlet of poems in English and Romanian parallel texts. (Integral Contemporary Literature Press). She has won prizes in many national competitions and has been the adjudicator for others.

- Poems must not exceed 60 lines nor carry any means of identifying the author.
- Multiple entries are permitted and each poem must be on a separate sheet.
- All entries must be received by the Competition Secretary no later than 28th February 2019.
- Name of the competitor & title(s) of poem(s) must be listed on the Entry Form or a cover sheet to which a cheque for the total entry fee should be attached.
- Entry Fees:- £5.00 for the initial poem and £3.50 for each additional one.
- Correct postage **must** be paid to avoid disqualification and forfeiture of your entry fee. The copyright of all poems remains with the author.
- Prize Money will be paid in pounds sterling; entry fees must likewise be paid in pounds sterling.

All West Sussex entrants will be further judged & the best poem by a West Sussex entrant will be awarded The Jim Johnston 'Chanctonbury Cup' and a separate prize of £25.00.
