BRYCE HOVERTER

We would like to introduce you to Bryce Hoverter, who is the Assistant Director of the SODA Board.

Bryce was born in Lancaster, Pennsylvania on July 8, 1974, and was diagnosed with Cerebral Palsy, and also is visually impaired.

When Bryce was two years of age, his family moved to West Seattle where he spent his early childhood, but then lived for about five years in Abilene, Texas.

After they moved back to the Southwest Seattle area, Bryce attended Kentwood High School, from where he graduated in

1995 at the age of 21.

For the past twelve years or so, Bryce has lived in an independent apartment with part-time caregivers in Auburn. He attended Camp Casey in the summers between the ages of 8 and 18, and participated in the Full Life Care day program for people with special needs between 2009 and 2015.

At Monica's invitation, Bryce started working for SODA in 2008 and has continued to work for SODA up to the present time.

He helps provide technical assistance to Monica, shops for SODA, and has helped with a Power Point presentation.

On January 22, 2011, Bryce and Monica were united in a Commitment Ceremony at University Christian Church, and now belong to Journey Christian Church in Lake City. Monica and Bryce enjoy going out to eat or to the movies and sang with the Total Experience Gospel Choir. Bryce is a big Seahawks fan and enjoys watching football, baseball and wrestling. He enjoys helping Monica and SODA.
