Miramare socks

Knit Intermediate 

Design: REGIA Designteam

SIZE

36/37 38/39 40/41 42/43

Instructions are for smallest size, with changes for larger sizes noted in different colors. When only one figure is given, it applies for all sizes.

MATERIALS

REGIA PREMIUM Cashmere, 100 g ball

Col. 00001 (weiß)

1 ball

Double pointed Needles 2.5 - 3.0 mm

1 cable needle

1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

BASIC PATTERN

Ribbed pattern: k1, p1, repeat to the end.

Stockinette stitch:

In Rows: RS: knit all sts, WS: purl all sts.

In Rd: knit all sts.

Cable pattern:

Multiples of 16 st: work according to the chart.

The numbers to the right of the chart indicate the odd-numbered rounds.

In the even-numbered Rd, work the st as they appear, or as described in the legend.

Work the 16-st repeat to the end of each round.

Work **Rds 1 – 40** twice.

GAUGE

Stockinette stitch, size 2,5 - 3,0 mm needles:

30 sts and 42 R/Rd = 10 x 10 cm

Cable pattern, size 2,5 – 3,0 mm needles:

32 M und 53 R/Rd = 10 x 10 cm.

If your gauge differs from the given gauge, use needles of a larger or smaller size accordingly.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 60/60/64/64 st, divide evenly over 4 needles and join to work in the round (= 15/15/16/16st on each needle).

For the cuff, work in ribbed pattern for 2 cm; in the last cuff Rd, make 1/1/0/0 st from the bar between 2 st = 64 st.

Then continue working the leg shaft in the cable pattern.

When you have worked 15 cm = 80 Rd from the beginning of the cable pattern, continue working in stockinette st; in the first stockinette st Rd, k 2/2/0/0 st together on each needle once = 60/60/64/64 st.

After the first stockinette st Rd, work a boomerang heel over the 30/30/32/32 st on Needles 1 and 4, following the tutorial "Knitting Socks with a Boomerang Heel."

Stitch division for the boomerang heel: 10/10/10 10/10/10 10/12/10 10/12/10 st.

After completing the boomerang heel, continue working in stockinette st over all stitches.

When the foot measures 18.5/20/21/22 cm, work the toe shaping, following the tutorial "Knitting Socks with a Boomerang Heel."

After the 1st decrease round, repeat the toe decreases as follows: once in the following 4th Rd, 2x in every following 3rd Rd, 3x in every 2nd round and 6/6/7/7 x in every Rd.

FINISHING

Thread the working yarn through the 8 remaining stitches and pull to close.

Weave in the end.

Work the second sock in the same way.

⊖ = p1

⊖ = in the odd-numbered Rd, slip 1 st together with 1 yo purlwise; in the even-numbered Rd, k the st together with the yo above it.



= work 7 st as a left-leaning cable (= place 4 st on a cable needle in front of the work, k the following 3 st, then k the 4 st from the cable needle)

ABBREVIATIONS

- k = knit
- p = purl
- RS = right side
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- WS = wrong side
