## A356 Proposals for South Perrott Published

Consultation meeting on 29th April

Following the involvement of a firm of consultants and widespread consultation with the villages involved, Dorset County Council has drawn up a set of proposals for changes to the A356 as it runs through South Perrott, Maiden Newton and Frampton. In South Perrott these ideas include:

- 'Gateways' at both ends of the village, marking more clearly the start of the built up area;
- The removal of the central white line;
- The creation of a 'pavement', using a slightly raised kerb and a distinctive material;
- Development of the Pound, using the same distinctive material as the 'pavement' and incorporating an information board;
- Creating 'crossing points', one adjacent to Church Hill as part of the Parrott Trail and another near to Pipplepen Lane, where parents cross to meet the school bus.
- Rationalising road signs to reduce confusion and avoid duplication

The final details, such as what the gateways will look like and the colour of the 'pavement' have yet to be decided and a meeting will be held in **South Perrott village hall on the 29th April between 1.00pm and 8.00pm** for further consultation and discussion. Mr Jody Foy, who is responsible for the A356, along with other officers from the County Council will be there to answer questions and seek views. Drawings of the plans will be available at the meeting.
