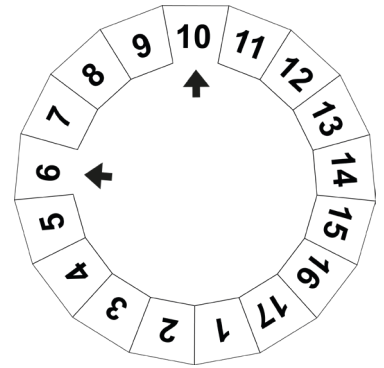

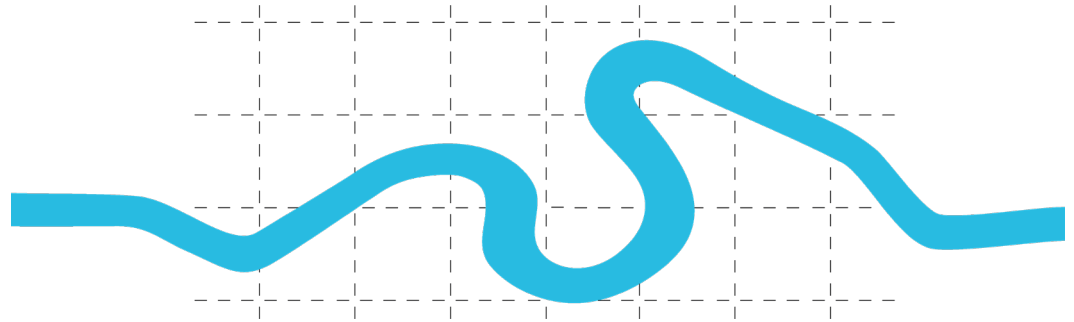

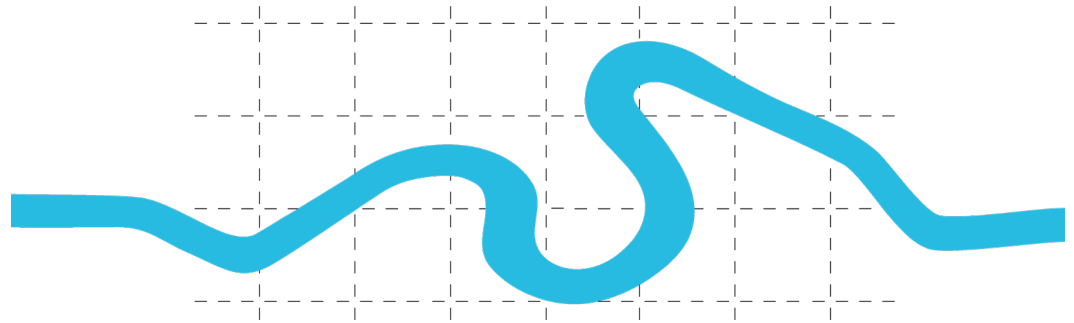
The Whanganui River in New Zealand was the first river in the world to be given its own rights.

242 of the world's rivers are shared by many people and flow through several countries. This can cause conflicts.

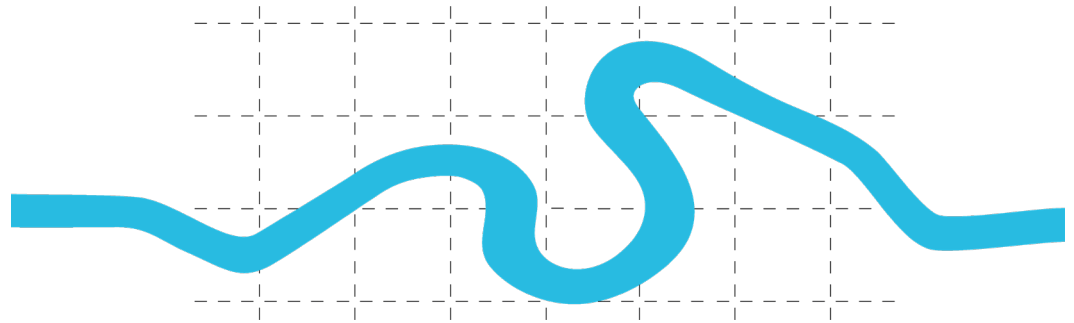


Ask others what the word share means to them.
