Dear St John's Chatham Family,

As you may know, we are in an incredibly blessed position in that a huge proportion of the capital cost for the current building work has been provided externally. This has come from a number of different sources including Future High Streets Fund, National Lottery Heritage Fund, Rochester Diocese, Medway Council, Benefact Trust and others. Through the generosity of these organisations and grant giving bodies we have seen God's faithful and sometimes surprising provision - at times we have been reminded of Nehemiah who not only received permission from King Artaxerxes to return to Jerusalem to rebuild the city wall, but this non-Israelite king also brokered the release of resources for this important kingdom work.

As the project advances we are now at the exciting stage of being able to give the church family (and wider community) the opportunity to be part of this incredible story of restoration and hope through financial partnership. As we launch the **#jointhestory** campaign we are inviting individuals to consider whether they may be able to give a one off gift or possibly even make a regular monthly commitment specifically towards the costs of the current building work and essential equipment that will be needed as we prepare to move back into the building.
