News from St Joseph's School:

On Thursday 31st March and Friday 1st April we had our Diocesan S48 Inspection. The focus of a S48 inspection is: the Catholic Life of the School, Religious Education and Collective Worship. All Catholic schools in England and Wales have a S48 inspection every five years. However due to Covid restrictions, S48 inspections have not been able to take place in England and Wales. Therefore, this inspection at St Joseph's was the first since 2015. The inspection lasted two days and was extremely busy with the Diocesan inspector observing and investigating all aspects of our Catholic Life, RE and Collective Worship. We will receive the Diocesan final report and school grading after the Easter holidays which will be shared with you. A big thank you from me to all of the staff, children, families and parishioners for all your support in presenting our school as the wonderful Catholic community, devoted to the teachings of Christ that it is.
