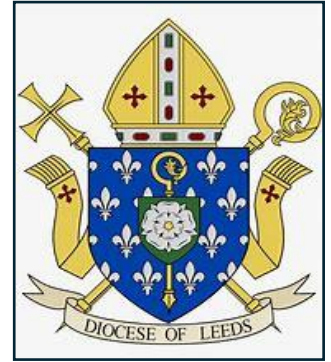

Stations of the Cross: Will be celebrated on Tuesday evenings at 6:30pm and on Fridays at 9am. Booklets are available (near the statue of Our Lady of Walsingham) to allow people to pray them privately. **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament:** Will take place from 4:00 to 5:00pm on Saturday Evenings during Lent, with **Confessions** available throughout the period.

CAFOD Family Fast Day: Friday 14th March 2025. Envelopes are available for you. You can also make online donations. You can Gift Aid your donations to CAFOD using the form attached to the envelopes. Poster downstairs with more information. CAFOD are also promoting "The Big Lent Walk" Walk 200Km in 40 days to help fight global poverty. Details downstairs.

Lenten Parish Project Nominations: Nominations are invited for which charity will be the beneficiary of our Lenten almsgiving as a parish this year. Nominations should be written on no more than 1 side of A4, put in a sealed envelope and handed to Fr Ben. They will then be anonymised, shortlisted by the Finance Committee, and put to a vote in the parish. We have received **one** nomination so far.

Lenten Lectures: After last year's talks on "Introduction to the Bible," Dr Geoffrey Turner, of our parish (and former Head of Theology at Leeds Trinity University) is to give 5 more talks during Lent. This time they will focus on the Gospel of Luke, beginning with "How to Read a Gospel." They will be in our Parish Hall on Thursdays at 7pm, starting on 13th March, then on 20th March, 27th March, 3rd April & 10th April.

Preparatory catechesis for the children: Saturday 15th March & Saturday 29th March. Children need to be in at least Year 3 to receive this Sacrament. Enrolment forms are now available. At the back of Church. They will also be available through the school. In signing up to receive the Sacrament of first Reconciliation, you are also agreeing for your child to proceed to First Holy Communion in Year 4, and Confirmation in Year 6.
