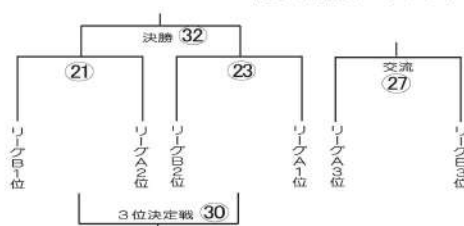

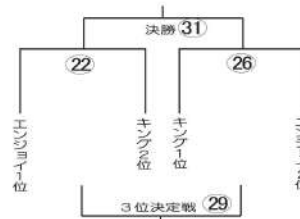

16 teams in a heated battle Street Hand Summer Festival

【Hokuto】 The "2025 All Japan Summer Festival in Hokkaido" street handball event (hosted by the comprehensive Ushio Sports Club and co-hosted by Street Handball Japan) was recently held at the Hokuto City Sports Park Multipurpose Square. A total of 16 teams, ranging from elementary school students to the general public, participated in the event and fought fiercely.

Street handball originated in Denmark and is enjoyed by people of all ages because it prohibits tackling, dribbling, and physical contact.

The first outdoor match was held in southern Hokkaido in August 2017.

The tournament took place on the 6th. Players passed the ball around to aim for the goal, while the defense made quick moves to read the passes and players' movements and block them. (Reporter: Junichi Yamazaki)
