INTRODUCTION

Tour of the old city and downtown by bike or on foot

The tour will bring the participants through the small alleys, the main streets of Palermo downtown and the old city. During the tour, the history of squares, old buildings, markets and people that animate the city will be told in an interactive way. The itinerary will unveil the various souls of Palermo: the stories, the charme, the scents and tastes, the myths and legends. The bike tour will follow this route: Via Libertà, Via Ruggero Settimo, the Capo market, the Ballarò market, the Jewish ghetto, the Vucciria market, Rione degli Spersi, Kalsa, Foro Italico and the Cala.

The walking tour will follow a different route according to the preferences of the participants.

Street Art tour by bike or on foot

The tour will show and tell the life of the old city adopting street art as a point of view. The tour by bike explores the following neighbourhoods: Albergheria, Kalsa, Loggia and Borgo Vecchio. During the tour the guide will show the many graffiti of Palermo and will talk about the meaning of graffiti, the life of the authors, the relationship of the graffiti with the city.

The walking tour starts from the Kalsa neighbourhood, goes through Ballarò and ends up at the Vucciria market.

A seaside tour discovering the village of Mondello by bike or on foot

The tour will let the participants discover the village of Mondello, where the white sand and the clear water will accompany the history and stories of the village, of its traditions and transformations which has influenced the relationship between the sea and the inhabitants of Palermo.

A walking tour to see old and new artcraft in the old city centre of Palermo

The tour will help the participants to discover the many traditional and new artcraft shops of the old city centre of Palermo. During the tour we will visit ateliers and old shops that still keeps the artcraft traditions alive renewing and adjusting it to modern life. The tourists will meet the artisans, who will explain the techniques they adopt and show how they make their products.

Bike and walking tour of Palermo, lasting around 3 hours, available on request both for individuals or groups. Suitable for families, adults and children, and conducted by official regional guides. The bike tours include bike rental and helmet. Tours are available in the following languages: English, French, Spanish, German and Arab
