

House rules Wagalicious Dance Crew



1. You are a passionate dancer who is excited to learn new things. 😊
2. Trainings are every Friday from 19.30 till at least 21.00 in Sports Centre de Bongerd. In the Christmas holidays and the summer holidays there are no trainings.
3. **You commit to the team, which means:**
 - a. Trainings are a priority, it is expected that you try to be there every Friday.
 - b. If you really need to cancel a training, it is your own responsibility to keep up with the missed choreographies before the next training.
 - c. You are on time for a training, which means at least 15 minutes before (19.15), so we can really start at 19.30. Make sure you are dressed and ready to dance.
 - d. You put some effort in the organisation for performances, social activities or the social media
 - e. Saying that you will join a competition or performance is binding, you can not cancel it after your confirmation.
4. Every member has a Wagalicious t-shirt and sweater/hoodie, this is part of the team-outfit. **Costs are around 50 euro.**
5. When lack of dedication is shown, the Board of SDF and captain of Wagalicious can consider removing you from the team.
6. To perform and participate at competitions we sometimes need an additional outfit. These costs are our own responsibility and will be decided upon together with the whole team.
7. Costs for participating in competitions and other events are our own responsibility.
8. Photos and videos in which Wagalicious team members appear, can be used as promotion material on social media.
9. In case a member share photos and/or videos with our choreographies on her/his personal social media, she/he has to mention the name of the team and the name of the choreographer.
10. Members of Wagalicious can be asked to give training on the regular classes of the Student Dance Factory and should therefore be open to do this. Help and guidance are offered by the board of the Student Dance Factory.
11. When you are accepted as a member of Wagalicious, you will always be a member unless you decide to quit or are not a student anymore.
