We're running for the university board to ensure a diverse and democratic UiB which takes the climate crisis seriously and gives students the means to succeed.

2020 was a year that challenged society and everyday life changed for many students in a day. Today we're seeing the light at the end of the tunnel and it's important that we look ahead and start planning for the time after the pandemic. We're running for the university board on a platform focused on reducing the impact of the pandemic on students. We also want to ensure that UiB implements new and innovative methods in both education and research.

Last year we were student representatives in the university board and we've made significant strides towards a better UiB. UiBs greenhouse gas emissions are finally falling. We've also ensured that UiB is planning to build more and better student workspaces. During the next year the university board will enact a new strategy for the years 2022-2025. We will fight to ensure that UiB focuses on how we, through education and research, can participate in the fight against climate change. In addition to this, we believe that UiB must work harder to ensure equality, inclusion and diversity among students and employees.

Work on the university board isn't a sprint, it's a marathon. Frequent change of the student representatives on the board allows the other board members to set the agenda. We want to change this. This fall an entirely new board will assume leadership of UiB and with our experience on the board already, and experience from the faculty board, "Kvarteret" and the law student association we will be a powerful voice for the students from day one. This way we can lay the groundwork for student involvement for the next four years.

During our time in the board we've accomplished several breakthroughs on behalf of students. Among this is a breakthrough from our first meeting in august 2020 which ensures that UiB systematically learns from our experiences from digital lectures and exams during the pandemic. We also fought to make sure that UiB no longer rents

lecture halls from organisations with discriminatory views on LGBT+ people. In addition to this we ensured that UiBs new area plan focuses on student workspaces.

One of our promises from last year was that we would fight for a new climate fund at UiB. We're proud to have won this fight and UiBs new climate fund works to further reduce UiBs emissions.

This next year we will focus on ensuring that UiBs new board focuses on the students. We also want UiB to increase its ambitions on climate change and ensure that we not only reduce our own emissions, but that we also participate in the fight against climate change abroad. At the same time UiB must focus on new ways to both educate and evaluate students. We also believe that UiB must negotiate to increase the number of trainee positions and internships that are available to students.

With our experience from the university board we're convinced that we are the right representatives to take UiB into the future. Our core promises this campaign are linked to what the board will work on this next year and we believe that they are all achievable in a year.
