COMPETITION RULES & SYSTEM

The WT Poomsae Competition Rules and Interpretation (in force as of May 14, 2019)

The WT Poomsae Ranking Bylaw (September 23, 2020)

The WT Athlete Classification Rules shall be applied.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Holder of a valid 2022 WT Global Athlete License;
- 2. Member of the team/club of a pertinent Member National Association, recognized by European Taekwondo Union or World Taekwondo;
- 3. Holder of Taekwondo Dan (Poom) certificate issued by the WT or Kukkiwon.

4. The age limits are based on the year 2022, not on the date. Poomsae (18 years old or older) contestants in the year of the 2022. Athletes born in 2004 or before are eligible.

All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport or identification card at the official weigh-in. For those athletes that are not adults, a written consent must be submitted (please find enclosed on the last pages) at the registration, signed by one of the parents or legal guardians, accepting their participation and all parts of the official invitation.

COACH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Minimum age of 18 years;
- 2. Holder of a valid 2022 WT Global Official License;
- 3. Coach is **not** allowed wearing Dobok.

METHOD OF COMPETITION FOR POOMSAE

Recognized Poomsae Competition

Two (2) Poomsae from designated Compulsory Poomsae will be decided by TD for each division and must be performed for all competitions.

ONLY FOR THE INDIVIDUAL CATEGORIES (M/F) <u>UNDER 30</u> and <u>UNDER 40</u>:

Single elimination tournament system

From Preliminaries to Finals: All competitions shall be conducted in a single elimination format. All athletes will be seeded based on the WT Poomsae Ranking of June (June 1st). If an athlete has no ranking points, he or she will not be seeded and will be placed in a random draw. Contestants shall perform two assigned Compulsory Poomsae for each round. Medals shall be awarded to the top four (4) contestants.

ALL OTHER CATEGORIES:

Cut-off System

- 1) Preliminaries: In case twenty (20) or more contestants/ pairs/teams are participating, the competition shall start from preliminary round with division of groups at different courts. After performing two (2) assigned Compulsory Poomsae, the top half of each group shall advance to semi-final based on the points.
- 2) Semi-final: In case nine (9) to nineteen (19) Contestants / pairs / teams are participating, competition shall start from semi-final. Contestants shall perform two (2) assigned Compulsory Poomsae and top eight (8) of them shall advance to final based on the points.
- 3) Final: When eight (8) or less contestants/ pairs/teams are participating, competition shall start from final round. Contestants shall perform two assigned Compulsory Poomsae for the final round. Medals shall be awarded to the top four (4) contestants/pairs/teams.

Free Style Poomsae Competition

Cut-off System (All Freestyle- categories (single Final Round))

- 1) FreeStyle Poomsae is the performance based on taekwondo techniques with composition of music and choreography.
- 2) Composition of FreeStyle Poomsae
 - 2.1 Yeon-mu line shall choice of contestant
 - 2.2 Performed techniques must be within boundary of taekwondo. The definition of

- taekwondo techniques shall be determined by WT Poomsae Committee, when contestant submits performance plan.
- 2.3 Music and choreography shall be the choice of contestants

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Contestants may compete in maximum two (2) categories in Recognized Poomsae and/or Freestyle Poomsae of competition unless he or she is limited by gender or age.

Duration of Contest:

- 1) Recognized Poomsae: Individual, Pair and Team competitions up to 90 seconds. (Break time between 1st Poomsae and 2nd Poomsae is 30 to 60 seconds.)
- 1) FreeStyle Poomsae: Individual, Pair and Mixed Team competitions from 90 seconds to 100 seconds.

SPORT ENTRIES - ONLINE REGISTRATION

The deadline for registration is set at:

12 August 2022, 23:59 CET

This deadline is applicable for all sport entries, payments and admitting all required documents.

APPLICABLE FEES

NEW ETU RULES ON ENTRY FEE PAYMENT

Teams and athletes have the following option:

OPTION 1:

- Standard entry fee:
 - o Individual

Early bird: 100 euro per registered individual athlete After 12 August: 125 euro per registered individual athlete

o Pairs and Teams

Early bird: 150 euro per registered pair/team After 12 August: 175 euro per registered pair/team

- All accredited team members stay in the official hotel accommodation chosen from the OC hotel list. This includes all team officials (coach, trainer, physio, doctor, head of team etc.).
- Minimum stay over in the official hotel is 1 night.

OPTION 2

Standard entry fee:

Individual

Early bird: 100 euro per registered individual athlete

After 12 August: 125 euro per registered individual athlete

Pairs and Teams

Early bird: 150 euro per registered pair/team

After 12 August: 175 euro per registered pair/team

All accredited team members pay an extra fee of 40 euro. This includes all team
officials (coach, trainer, physio, doctor, head of team etc.).

If you do not stay in the official hotel, the team automatically chooses for option 2!!

Extra accreditation cards

Per 5 athletes, 1 coach accreditation card is issued. If your team requires additional accreditation cards, a fee of 50 euro is charged.

Protest fee

In case the WT Competition Rules allow a protest, a non-refundable fee of 200 euro shall be paid.

SPECTATORS

Spectators pay the following admission fees:

1 – day admission: 10 euro2 – day admission: 15 euro

NO REFUND

The Organizing Committee does not refund entry fees paid. In case the athlete has not been removed from the list of participants before the deadline his/her team or official must fully (100%) pay the entry fee(s) for participation. In case of no show the invoice will be send to the team after the tournament.

Dobok

WT approved poomsae competition uniforms:

1. **Cadet Division** (Ages 12-14): White top with red and black collar, plus blue pants for males; the same top, but with red pants, for females.



2. **Junior and Senior** Division (Ages 15-50): White top with dark blue pants for males; white top with light blue pants for females.



3. **Master** Division (Ages 51 and up): Yellow top and dark blue pants for both males and females.



Identification of NOC Code and Manufacturer

National flag shall be located between 3.5cm below the right shoulder line of upper garment. Flag size should be 10cm width x 7cm height.



NOC Code is a three-letter National Olympic Committee abbreviation, and it shall be printed at the back of the upper garment of Poomsae competition uniform in black color and centered 12cm from the top line of the upper garment within the size of 30cm width x 12cm height. The font of the letters shall be in bold "Verdana".



The number of manufacturer's identification (name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be one per garment within 20cm² except at the location of the WT logo according to the related WT guidelines in force as of this event. The end of the belt must be at least10cm or higher above the knee.

FIELD OF PLAY REGULATIONS

By accepting an accreditation card, all accredited persons agree to comply with the Field of Play regulations applicable at Taekwondo events. Only the competitors and their coaches will have admittance with valid accreditations to the contest areas.

AWARDS

Individual awards

1st place - gold medal and certificate

2nd place – silver medal and certificate

3rd place - two bronze medals and certificate

All participants will receive a certificate of participation.

ACCESS TO FIELD OF PLAY

Only for one (1) coach, one (1) athlete and one (1) officially licenced Medical Doctor are allowed to enter the Field of Play with their official accreditation. The OC has the right to refuse participants access to the Field of Play.

MEDICAL AND ANTI-DOPING

Applicable doping rules

The WT Anti-Doping Rules and the WADA Anti-Doping Code are applicable. Compulsory random doping tests may be conducted among the all athletes. World Taekwondo and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the event. Therefore, all participating contestants are required to submit their latest and most accurate Athlete Location (Whereabouts Info) Forms to WT.

Therapeutic Use Exemption

Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and WADA Anti-Doping Code for therapeutic purposes are requested to visit the website of WADA and make online filing of their TUE applications on ADAMS. Report TUE applications also to the WT Sport Department via sport@worldtaekwondo.org.

INDEMNITIES

It is the responsibility of each registering team to ensure that their athletes and team officials have filled out the indemnification forms correctly and have duly signed them, thereby indemnifying WT, ETU, the Organizing Committee and all other officials and athletes from any claims of injuries, losses or otherwise arising in the course of participation at the G2 European Cup Poomsae 2022 or any activities linked therewith.

It is the responsibility of each registered team to ensure and guarantee that sufficient insurance coverage has been arranged for all athletes, team officials and other participants. Without sufficient insurance coverage, teams will not be allowed to compete.

Please fill out the Personal Indemnity Forms and return them to the Organization Committee before 15 August 2022. Each participant (athletes, team officials, etc.) has to fill out the indemnification form.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

All participating athletes, coaches and team officials shall have mandatory a medical insurance that covers medical care and in case of emergency repatriation to home country. All relevant documents proving that such an insurance is present, including insurance policy papers, should be taken to the event in case a medical situation occurs.

CORONA COVID-19 OUTBREAK

General

The OC cannot predict the developments in the next comings months with regard to the Corona COVID-19 outbreak in Europe. The teams have to bear in mind that due to the uncertain nature of the Corona COVID-19 outbreak and sole authority of each government on how to respond, restrictions to access the Host country may be applicable. It is the responsibility of each and every participating team to make sure they meet all entry requirements in order to enter the Host country and to monitor the Swedish policy with regard to entry policies.

Sufficient insurance

The teams are strongly urged and advised to make sure to have their own sufficient travel, cancellation and medical insurance.

Liability

In this respect, please be informed that the OC shall not and cannot be held liable for any expenses and costs incurred by the teams for travelling to the event in case of cancellation of the event due to (further) outbreak of the Corona COVID-19 virus in the Host Country. The teams are strongly urged and advised to make sure to have their own sufficient travel, cancellation and medical insurance. The OC shall not accept any claims or requests for compensation in case of cancellation of the event.
