- End conference Lund university, Sweden, October 2018.



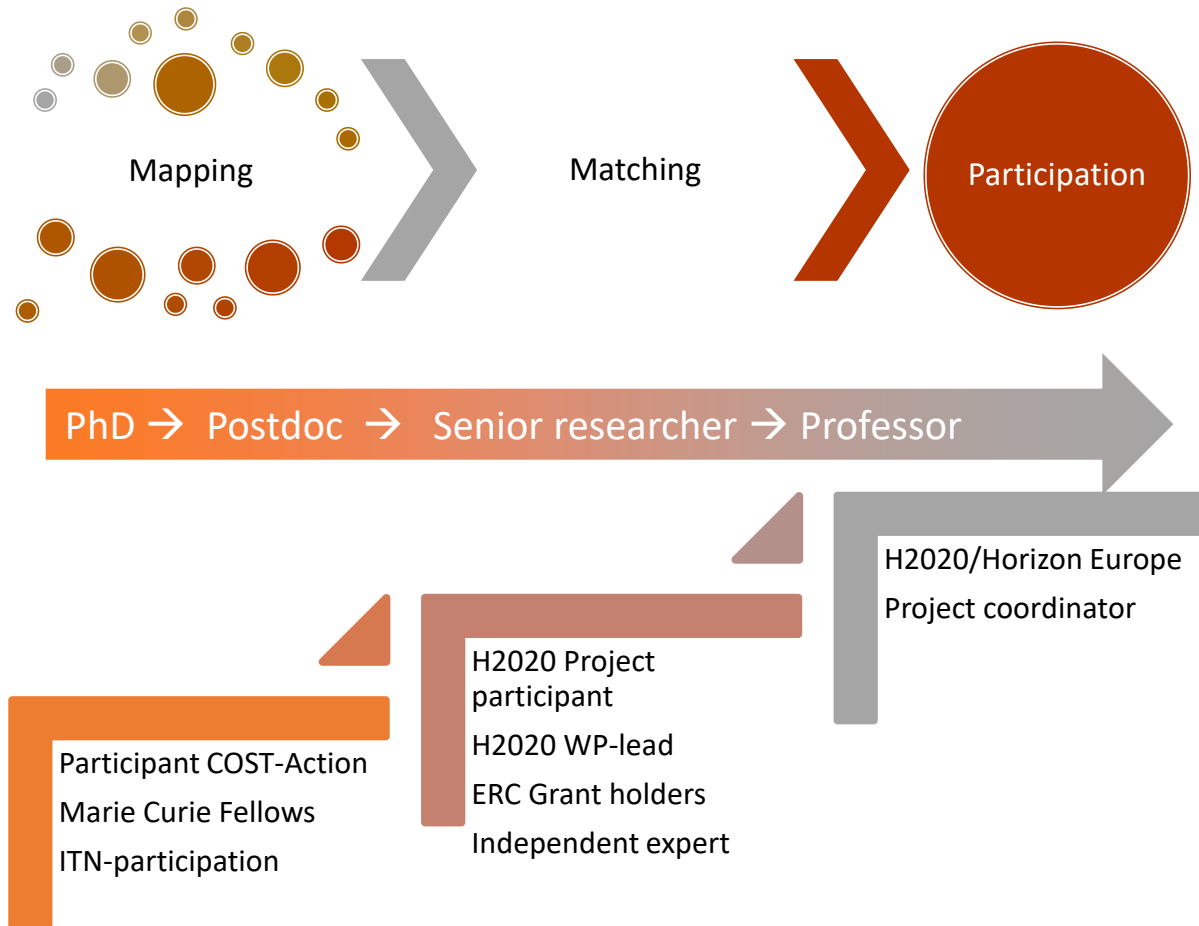

Goal: increase participation of Swedes in H2020 and FP9





Why bother?

- Money: Horizon Europe (FP9) 2021-2027 missions = up to EUR 10 billion
- Sustainable work important: more and stronger research necessary to meet challenges
- Easier: FP8 and FP9 less bureaucratic than before
- Flexible: Many different types of funding instruments/roles
- Internationalisation: Increasing focus on and flexible approach to international partners





Suggestions

- Think impact! SMEs, public sector, end users
- Added value: comparative studies
- Evaluation criteria: excellence, impact, implementation
- Collaborate! EU members, non-EU members, other disciplines (social sciences)
- Not research programmes but political instruments in which research and innovation is needed
- FP9. Goal: competition and growth. Focus: cohesion, impact, openness.
- FP9 more impact: European Innovation Council, **R&I Missions**
- FP9 more openness: **international cooperation**, open science policy, new approach to partnerships.

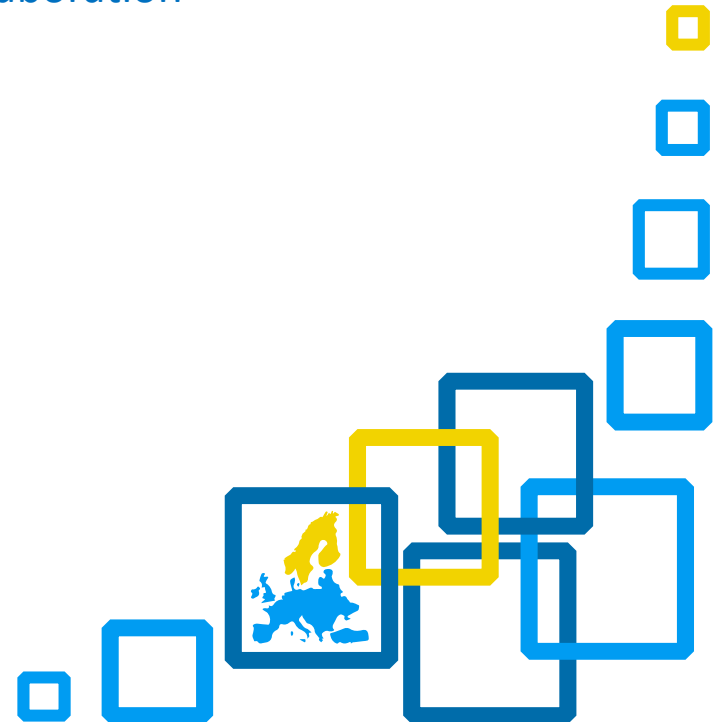
International cooperation

Eligible countries H2020

- Member states of the European Union
- Associated countries: Iceland, Norway, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, FYRM, Montenegro, Serbia, Turkey, Israel, Moldova, Switzerland, Faroe Islands, Ukraine, Tunisia, Georgia, Armenia
- Third countries eligible for funding (Annex A)
- Exceptionally (bilateral agreement or identified in WP or deemed essential for carrying out action)

Eligible countries FP9

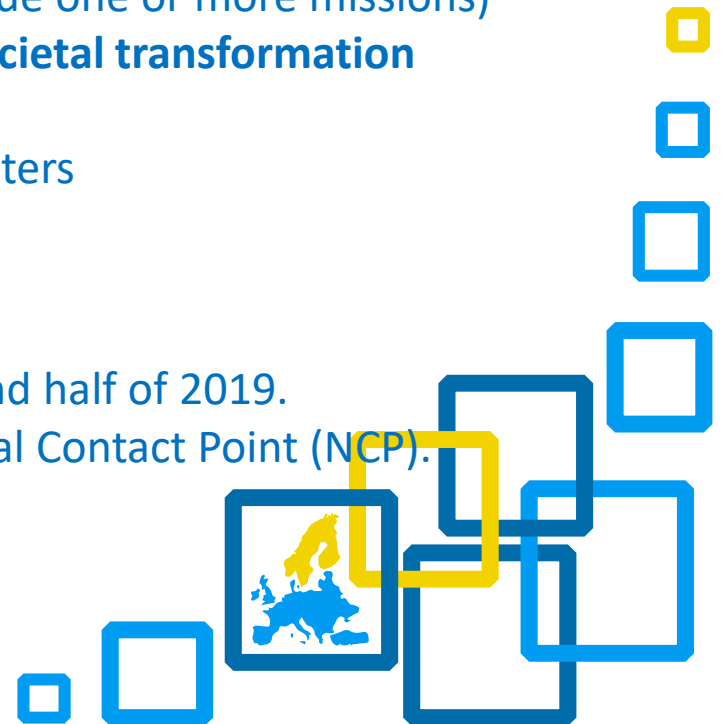
- MIGRATION-04-2020: Inclusive and innovative practices for the integration of post 2015 migrants in local communities (*decent work*)
- MIGRATION-10-2020: Innovative practices for the integration of newly arrived migrants into societies (*decent work*)
- TRANSFORMATIONS-04-2020: Innovative approaches to urban and regional development through cultural tourism (*decent work*)
- **TRANSFORMATIONS-18-2020: Technological transformations, skills and globalisation – future challenges for shared prosperity (*quality of work*)**
- DT – GOVERNANCE-05-2020: New forms of delivering public goods and inclusive public services (*OSH data, public institutions*)



FP9/Horizon Europe **missions** (forget societal challenges)

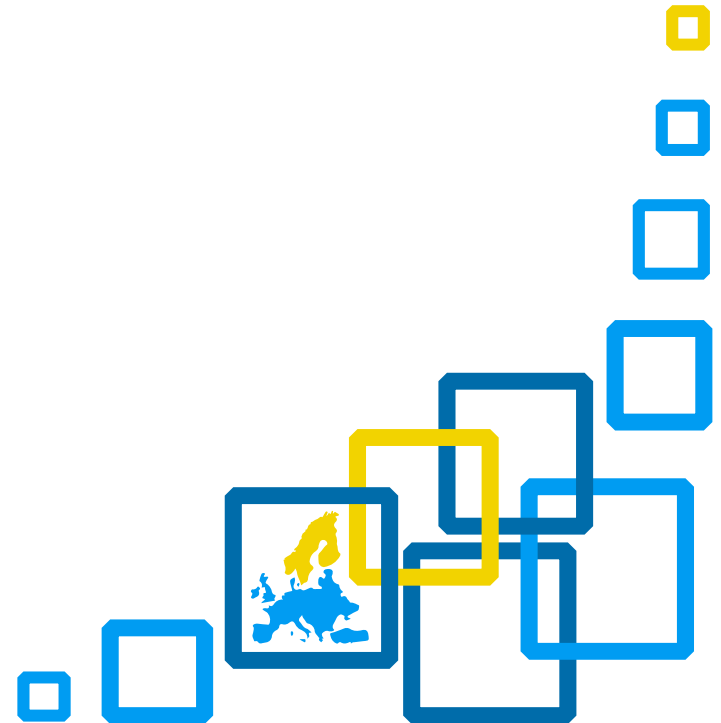

- Connected to UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 8=Decent Work) and the 2015 Paris agenda (climate)
- Each mission= portfolio of activities aimed at transformation. More proactive than H2020.
- Recently identified:5 mission areas (may include one or more missions)
 1. **Adaptation to climate change, including societal transformation**
 2. **Cancer**
 3. Healthy oceans, seas, coastal and inland waters
 4. Climate-neutral and smart cities
 5. Soil health and food
- Work programmes are developed in the second half of 2019.
You can lobby in your country via your National Contact Point (NCP).



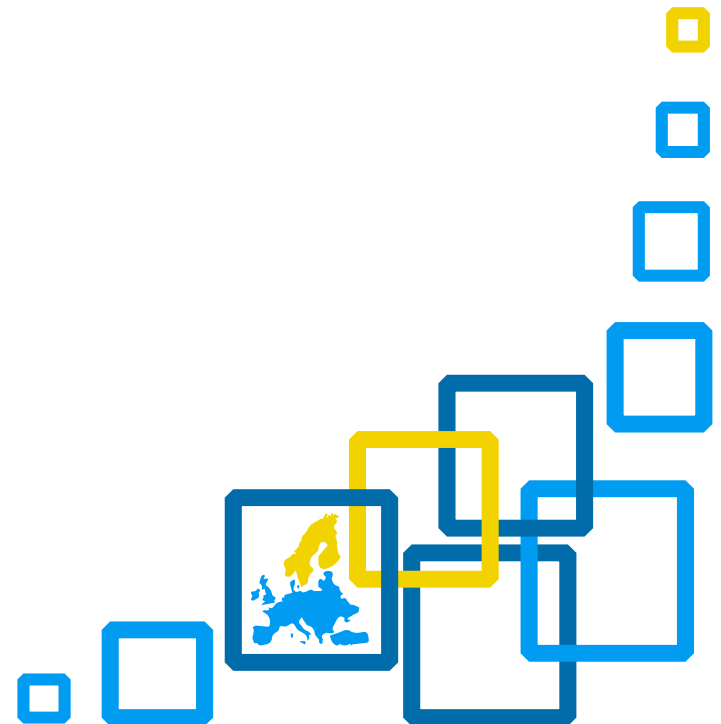
