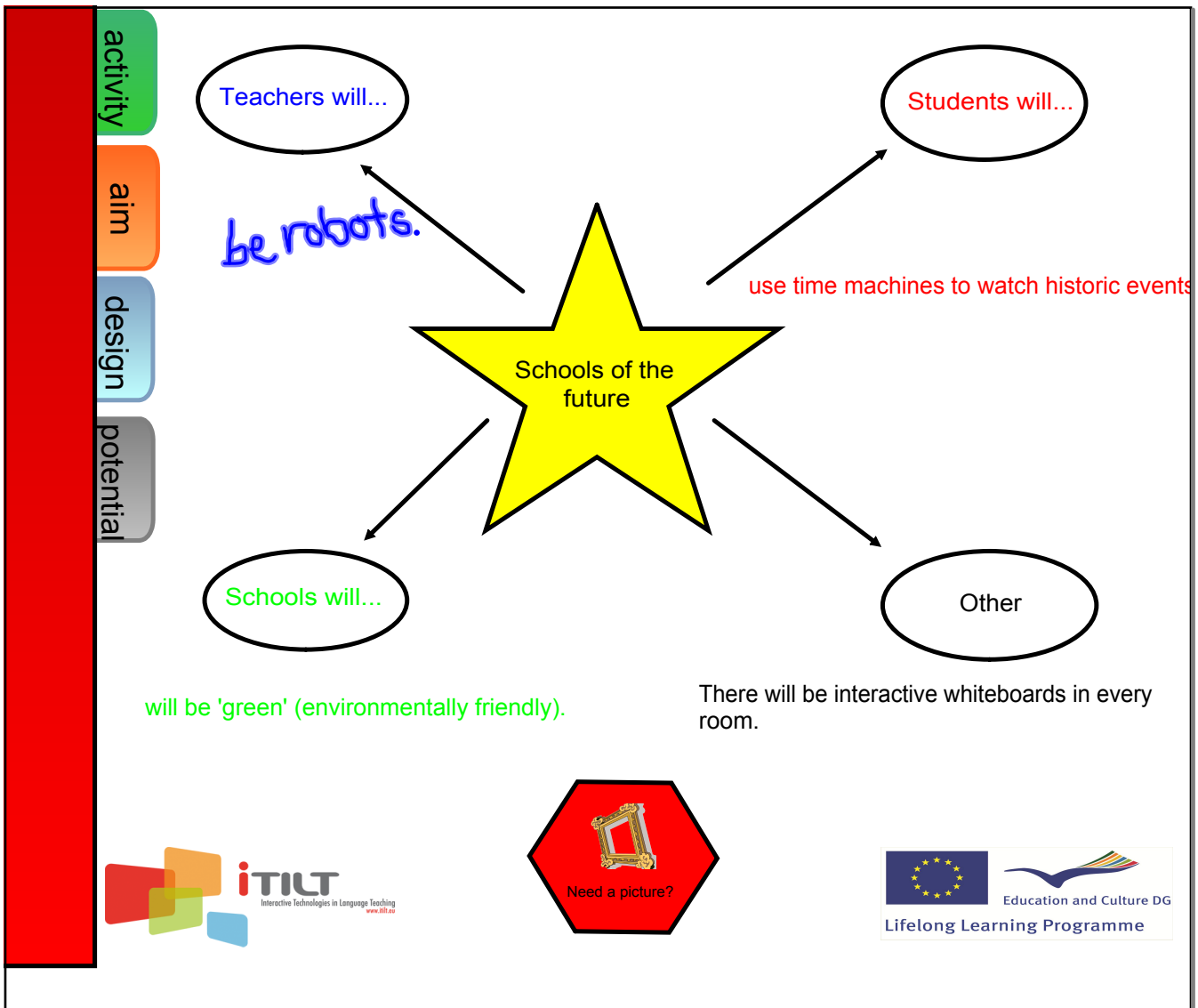

- Prepare yourselves to explain your picture to the class. You can use the words from the brainstorming activity, for example.



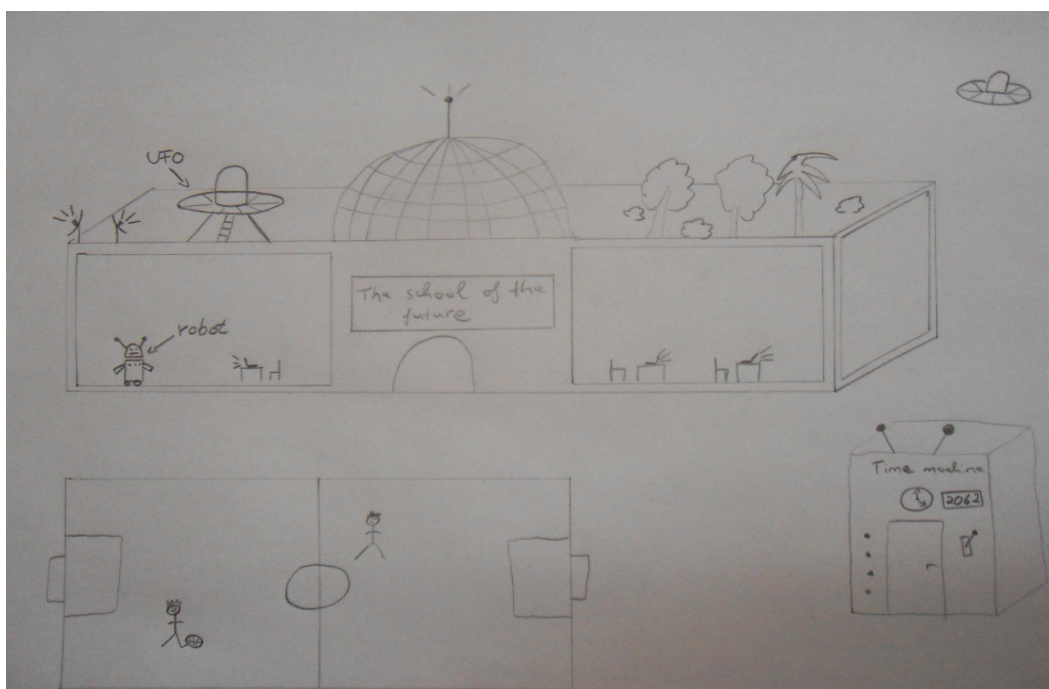
