
## 3D Dino Template

- 1. Print dino out on to light weight card.
- 2. Colour in dino
- 3. Cut out along the black solid lines
- 4. Fold along dashed lines
- 5. Stick tab 1 (up to the first dashed line) under the tab on the other side of the head
- 6. Stick both tab 2s to the head, in between the nose bump and the eye
- 7. Stick both tabs 3 to the underside of the jaw. Your head should be one complete 'block'.
- 8. Fold tab 4 in on itself and stick to the opposite body section.
- 9. Stick the larger tab 5 to the inside of the body, just above the tail and stick the smaller tab 5 to the back of the body, just at the base of the 'neck'.
- 10. Feed the arms in between the top belly flap (just above tab 4) and the side body sections.
- 11. Stick the outside section of tab1 to the back of the neck, so there is no gap between the head and the body.
- 12. Finally, bend the tail out slightly where it joins the joins the body and stand. Adjust the tail bend until the dino is stable it acts as a counterbalance to the rest of the dino's body.
