The organizers have the right to change the judge. The board has the right to refuse registration without stating the reasons.

Important: Exhibitors are formally prohibited from publicly presenting prizes their dogs have won at other shows. Liability: The Committee cannot accept the slightest responsibility for theft, loss or damage to dogs or objects present on the premises. Exchange dog is not allowed! Participants must respect the distance from other dogs, as the commission declines all responsibility for bites or accidents. All accidents not specified in the rules and all disputes regarding their implementation will be decided immediately and without the possibility of appeal. Exhibitors who need more information can contact the exhibition secretariat.

Classification (art.23 of the Regulations of the exhibition recognized by the Royal Cynological Union Sint-Hubertus. It is prohibited to participate in more than one class of individual competition except participation in the Progeny class.

- 1. **MINOR PUPPY CLASS**: dogs from 3 to 6 months on the day of the show. This class doesn't compete neither for the C.A.C. nor for the B.O.B.
- 2. **PUPPY CLASS**: dogs from 6 to 9 months on the day of the show. This class doesn't compete neither for the C.A.C. nor for the B.O.B.
- 3. **JUNIOR CLASS**: dogs from 9 to 18 months on the day of the show. This class doesn't compete for the C.A.C. but will compete for the B.O.B.
- 4. **INTERMEDIATE CLASS**: dogs from 15 to 24 months on the day of the show. This class qualifies for the C.A.C.
- 5. OPEN CLASS: for all dogs from 15 months on the day of the show. This class qualifies for the C.A.C.
- 6. **BREEDER CLASS**: for all dogs from 15 months on the day of the show, they come from the exhibitor's own breeding. This class qualifies for the C.A.C.
- 7. CHAMPION CLASS: dogs from 15 months on the day of the show, having obtained the title of national or international champion. A photocopy of the certificate is required otherwise the dog will be automatically reclassified in the open class. This class qualifies for C.A.C.
- 8. **VETERAN CLASS**: dogs from 8 years on the day of the show. This class doesn't compete for the C.A.C. but will compete for the B.O.B.
- 9. **BRACE CLASS**: Two dogs from the same variety but different sex owned by the same exhibitor. They must also be entered in a class of individual competition.
- 10. **GROUP CLASS**: Minimum three dogs from the same variety, without consideration of the sex, owned by the same exhibitor or bred by the same breeder. They must also be entered in a class of individual competition.
- 11. **PROGENY CLASS**: For a dog or bitch shown at the show with a minimum of his/her three offsprings that had to be entered in the individual class. The classification only takes into account the value of the offsprings and prizes are awarded regardless of the age and condition of their parent, when his presence at the show is very desirable. In this class, the exception applies for participation of a dog in more than one class of the individual competition referred to in Article 23 of the Exhibition Regulations.

Important notice: Any false statement that would have led to the entry of a dog in a class to which he is not entitled, will entail the annulment of the result obtained and the revocation of the titles that the dog would have won and, if applicable, the sanction provided by the regulations.
