## 2755/01 TO CONSIDER ANY MATTERS CONCERNING THE PLAYING FIELD, VILLAGE HALL CAR PARK AND CCTV SYSTEMS

It was **RESOLVED**\_to purchase an Icemaster 50 pedestrian salt spreader at a cost of £125.00 for use in the Village Hall car park in the event of bad weather. It was noted that the product previously agreed for £114.99 is no longer available.

<u>2755/02</u> It was reported that a horse and cart had been taken across the field 26 November 2019. It was agreed that no action will be taken at this time, however, should a further incident be reported then contact will be made with the owner as signage on entry to the playing field clearly states that no access is allowed for horses.

<u>2755/03</u> On 14 January 2020 the pre-school reported a car which appeared to have been left overnight in the car park. Someone had alerted the police who attended and moved the occupants on. The CCTV will be reviewed for any anti-social behaviour. The play group will be asked to report to the Parish Council should any similar incidents occur.

<u>2755/04</u> The children's football team had asked if it was possible to rope off the football field area between training on Saturday and playing on Sunday as the pitch was getting extremely muddy. Following discussion, it was felt impractical to do so and was due to the current extreme wet weather conditions.

<u>2755/05</u> A review of the insurance policy is required due to concern over cracks in the changing room in the Village Hall as there may be issues if the cause is related to the trees surrounding the Hall.

2755/06 It was agreed to defer discussion regarding the defibrillator to the next meeting.

<u>2755/07</u> It was **RESOLVED** to approve the purchase of a sign requesting that persons contact the Village Hall Committee if someone wished to hire the playing field.
