<u>2421/02</u> The following new application was considered:

FUL/MAL/18/00339 Variation of condition 5 of approved planning permission FUL/MAL/15/00592 (Proposed 3 bedroom dwelling with detached garage)	Chene View Park Lane Tolleshunt Knights	It was RESOLVED to object to this application. A fence instead of a hedge would have an urbanising effect on the street scene. It was also noted that the plans were not accurate – the property now has an in/out driveway which has not received planning permission, and the garden room has a flat instead of a pitched roof. It was also noted that under a previous permission Meadow Nursery should have been demolished when the new property was inhabited, but this has not been done. These matters will be raised with Maldon District Council enforcement.
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<u>2421/03</u> Other planning issues: Chene View Park Lane - Development not in accordance with plans – change of roof to extension: There is no breach of planning control that Maldon District Council can act upon.

At the same site there is a case open regarding changes to the landscaping at the front of the property (17/00382/OPCOMP).

It was noted that Maldon District Council is currently setting fees for its GDPR service to Parish Councils. This item will be reconsidered when the fees have been set.

2423/01 TO CONSIDER ANY HIGHWAYS ISSUES

Local Highways Panel; suggestion from Tiptree Parish Council that Tolleshunt Knights Parish Council should apply to the Local Highways Panel for a speed limit on Factory Hill. Tiptree Parish Council will be advised that Factory Hill does not lie within the Maldon LHP district.

Tiptree Parish Council will be advised that the litter bin in Park Lane Nature Reserve was definitely overflowing at the time that the matter was originally brought to its attention. A large number of potholes at various locations in Brook Road, Barnhall Road and Tudwick Road will be reported to Highways.

2424/01 PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

Currently the footpaths are very wet. A complaint has been received that the footpath from Barnhall Road to Rectory Road is flooded.

There are still some problems with the distribution of the Tribune in parts of Tolleshunt Knights. Councillor Mr Long will pursue this matter.

It was noted that Tiptree Heath Football Club has agreed to decorate the changing rooms in the Hall free of charge.
