



## Tomas Raae / Eline Hellerud Åsbakk: Kollektivet

Nordic sound and words, improvisation, and ambient cinematic atmosphere form the foundation for inviting the audience into an enchanted electronic forest of musical storytelling. Elves, forests, mist, campfire dances, and the first light of dawn take shape through tones, text, improvisation, and dusty beats.

Tomas Raae & Eline Hellerud Åsbakk's collective creates a sonic universe where acoustic instruments, vocals, and live electronic elements blend into a space between open and playful improvisations rooted in experimental and improvisational jazz, and an immersive soundscape reminiscent of cinematic ambient and drone music. This sensory and curious form of music aims for the ears, the heart, and the soul. A story that begins with the Nordic lands, nature, and its people, yet ultimately becomes universal—a reflection on the essence of being human.

"The old Nordic songs are like small miracles—filled with precision, poetry, and reflections on life's great mysteries. I was deeply moved when I delved into them," says Tomas Raae.

The concert is inspired by the upcoming album \*'...før de spredtes'\*, a modern interpretation of the Nordic musical heritage. The album weaves together newly written songs and folk melodies from the period 1300–1870, paying homage to the poetry and depth of this ancient musical tradition.
