

# DANISH AUTHOR RETURNS FOR MORE INSPIRATIONS

Dan Turell, well known Danish author, journalist and poet — one of his latest books, a thriller, was "Mord pa Malta" (Murder in Malta) — is expected to return to Malta this week accompanied by his wife, the actress Chili Turell and their three-year-old daughter Lotus Maria.

He first came to Malta in 1973 and since then returned on four other occasions — enough for

him to regard Malta as "my other homeland". The Turells will be staying at the Mellieha Holiday Centre for a month.

"Murder in Malta", his third crime novel, has been awarded "The Golden Handcuffs" by the Edgar Allan Poe club of Denmark. Quite recently he has received the popular Danish humorist prize, "The Peanuts" — so called after the well-known comic strip.

Mr. Turell has written more than 60 books — from books of poetry to short stories and essays, travel stories and thrillers.

With the Turells will come the author's electronic Printer. For Dan Turell hopes that the visit to Malta will result in further inspiration to write another book on Malta and the Maltese.
