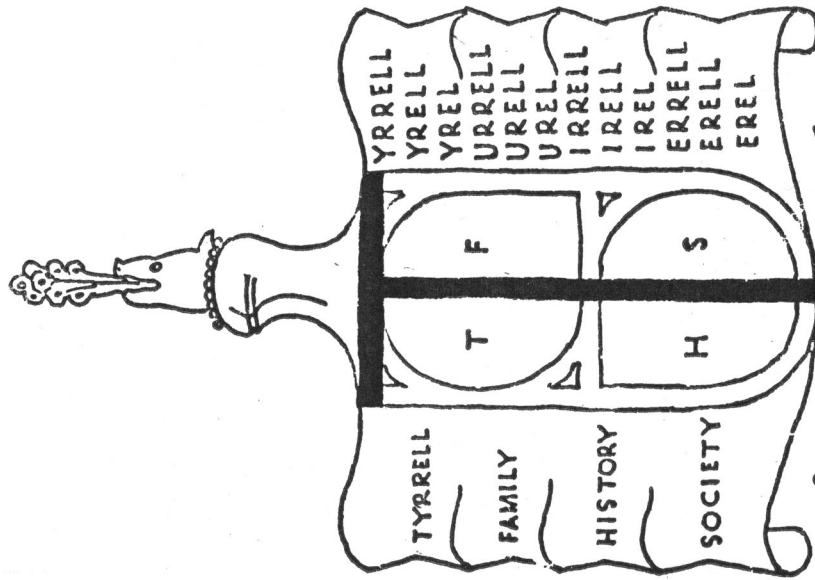

WHY A TYRRELL FAMILY HISTORY SOCIETY ?

It has recently become very evident through the various news media, that throughout the world, an ever increasing number of people are finding an absorbing interest in looking into their "Family Tree". In many cases this became the commencement of wanting to investigate in greater detail the lives of their forebears, whereby they find themselves developing an interest in Genealogy and Heraldry to varying degrees. This popular interest has resulted in a very rapid development of Regional Societies, specialising in Genealogy and Heraldry, appropriate to a given locality.

Our Society came into being on Saturday, June 10th 1978 at the Inaugural Meeting held at the Y.W.C.A. in Great Russell St, London. This was subsequent to our Chairman John, at a Conference of the Federation of Family History Societies in Portsmouth, whereby he became aware of the advantages of the "One Name Societies", and felt that like him, there must be other Tyrrells (Var.) who were, or would like to trace their family ancestry and could help or be helped by the formation of a Society devoted to the Tyrrell, Tyrrell, Terrell, Turrell, Tirrells etc, etc.

The first project was the production of a quarterly Newsletter, going along with a membership drive. At the moment our Membership Nos. now extend to over 580 households. Many reference books have been printed and re-printed, as well as the organising of four meetings per year, where much related memorabilia is always displayed. Until you have the pleasure of experiencing attending any of our meetings, it would be difficult to describe the friendship that always prevails, due to the common bond of our name and family.

Already much interesting research has been made by our Society and is made available to all members through our Newsletters, many members have been greatly helped by this information, as have other genealogists and historians in the United Kingdom and throughout the world.

AIMS AND OBJECTS.

1. To maintain an association of those interested in the origin, history and development of the various branches of the Tyrrell Family, including any of its variants such as :- Tyrel, Tyrell, Turrell, Turell, Turel, Tirrell, Tirel, Tirell, Terrell, Terel etc, etc.
2. To hold meetings once or twice a year at places of special interest to the Tyrrells.
3. To circulate a regular Newsletter to all members drawing attention to matters of topical interest, including reports of research work aimed at the history and genealogy of the families involved.
4. To promote the preservation of documents, monuments, and other material of special significance to the members.
5. To foster the study of Tyrrell Genealogy with the intention of sponsoring the publication of definitive research when appropriate.
6. To promote Regional and House Groups.

A blood relationship to a branch of the Tyrrell family, or any of its variants, is not an essential condition of membership. As much of the material in the Tyrrell Archives could be of general interest to historians, demographers, students and others, it is anticipated that many of them will find membership beneficial.
