Furthermore, the wider Middle East is a conflict prone region, characterized by structural instability and frequent crises. Therefore, the process towards the establishment of a Free Zone has always been complex and rich in obstacles. Moreover, in this geopolitical scenario, the security perceptions of Middle Eastern countries represent a crucial element, which needs to be properly considered in order to foster arms control, non-proliferation and disarmament in the MENA region.

For these reasons, during the conference it will be interesting to address the debate around the well-known dilemma *peace or disarmament first?*, by elaborating possible paths for a constructive dialogue in the region, while defining the way forward for a significant EU contribution in this regard. Thus, the main aim of the talk will be to propose renewed ideas and perspectives for the EU engagement in the Middle East Weapons of Mass Destruction Free Zone establishment process, towards security and peace in the region and beyond.
