WHAT IS A SUPPORTED INTERNSHIP?

They are fully-funded, extended work placements, in a role shaped around the needs of the business, with a view to paid employment for the Intern at the end of the placement.

Requirements and hours in the workplace can vary and are agreed with the employer. This is dependent on business needs and the needs of the individual Intern. Interns are also assigned a Job Coach who will support both them and the employer throughout the programme. This includes support with making reasonable adjustments, training staff, developing the Intern in line with agreed targets and providing extra resources where necessary.

Interns' skills, interests and aspirations are matched to specific roles. Interns join a work placement 3-4 days per week and remain in class for one day per week. Interns' performance is assessed by employer with view to paid employment at the end of the programme.
