

Averages

Mean	Mean = the average To find the mean, add all data in a set together and divide them by the amount of data.
Median	Median = the middle number To find the median, list all data in ascending order to locate the middle number. If there are two numbers in the middle, take the mean of these numbers.
Mode	Mode = the most frequent number To find the mode, identify which numbers occur the most. (Bi-modal sets occur when there are two numbers that appear the most.)
Range	Range = the range of the data set To find the range, take the smallest number in the set away from the largest.

Exam tip!

Mean, median, mode and range should be easy marks but don't forget this one vital step!

Always rearrange the data in ascending order
