



Averages

Mean	<p>Mean = the average</p> <p>To find the mean, add all data in a set together and divide them by the amount of data.</p>
Median	<p>Median = the middle number</p> <p>To find the median, list all data in ascending order to locate the middle number. If there are two numbers in the middle, take the mean of these numbers.</p>
Mode	<p>Mode = the most frequent number</p> <p>To find the mode, identify which numbers occur the most. (Bi-modal sets occur when there are two numbers that appear the most.)</p>
Range	<p>Range = the range of the data set</p> <p>To find the range, take the smallest number in the set away from the largest.</p>

Exam tip!

Mean, median, mode and range should be easy marks but don't forget this one vital step!

Always rearrange the data in ascending order
