Expectation		Failure to meet expectations can result in:
1.	Students are to display excellent standards of behaviour and conduct at all times and in all areas of school.	<ul> <li>Behaviour interview with form tutor</li> <li>Behaviour interview with Head of Sixth Form</li> <li>Sanctions such as detentions / isolation / exclusions imposed</li> <li>In extreme cases, permanent exclusion</li> </ul>
2.	Students are to attend form every day from 8.30 – 8.45.	<ul> <li>Interview with form tutor or Head of Sixth Form</li> <li>Loss of freedom of movement after 12.00pm</li> <li>Directed afternoon registration with Head of Sixth Form to make up the time lost and discuss failure to attend form</li> <li>Persistent failure to attend form will be deemed defiance which will then be treated as misconduct. Behaviour sanctions will then be imposed and sanction processes escalated as appropriate.</li> </ul>
3.	Students must be punctual to form and all lessons every day.	<ul> <li>Interview with form tutor or Head of Sixth Form</li> <li>Loss of freedom of movement after 12.00pm</li> <li>Directed afternoon registration with Head of Sixth Form</li> </ul>
4.	Students must fully adhere to the dress code at all times.	- Students will be sent home to change
5.	Students will only leave site after 12.00pm.	<ul> <li>Interview with Head of Sixth Form</li> <li>Loss of freedom of movement after</li> <li>12.00pm.</li> </ul>

6. Students will endeavour to maintain excellent levels of attendance, above 96%, throughout the year (see attendance policy for further guidance).	See full attendance policy for further details.
7. Students will meet all homework and coursework deadlines and engage fully in independent study.	<ul> <li>Student and parental contact from teaching staff</li> <li>Detentions set to catch up on work</li> <li>Free periods directed to be completed in the study room by Head of Sixth Form</li> <li>Student and parental contact from Head of Sixth Form and an intervention plan put in to place</li> </ul>
8. Students will source and complete I weeks work experience during the summer term of Year 12.	<ul> <li>Failure to meet this expectation is not an option, it is compulsory.</li> </ul>
<ol> <li>Students will attend and complete all internal and external examinations.</li> </ol>	<ul> <li>Student and parental contact from teaching staff</li> <li>Student and parental contact from Head of Sixth Form</li> </ul>

Repeated failure to adhere to any of the points above will be considered serious misconduct.
