## **GCSE Results**

GCSE results will be issued at 9 o'clock Thursday 22nd August 2024 in the Sycamore Hall. Results will be emailed to students' school email accounts later in the day. The results at this stage are provisional to allow for any enquiries about results to take place.

## 6<sup>th</sup> Form

Students who are coming back to 6<sup>th</sup> Form **must confirm** their place on results day at the 6<sup>th</sup> Form table in the Sycamore Hall and students who now wish to return for 6<sup>th</sup> Form, please go to this table. If you are not returning to 6<sup>th</sup> Form please can you visit the Destinations table before you leave.

## **Post Results**

If students are unhappy with their mark, they can have their exam script reviewed. It is important that students speak to their subject teacher, Head of Department or SLT to discuss their results before making any decisions. A clerical re-check or review of marking can result in a higher grade, the **lowering** of a grade or the same result as originally awarded. **Reviewers will not re-mark the script.** The review fee and the consent in writing or by school email from the student is required before any requests will be processed.

All enquiries about results and applications will be dealt with when school reopens on 2nd September 2024. Please remember that applications for these services are time sensitive and will not be accepted by the exam board after the published deadline.

## • GCSE Review of Marking Monday 23rd September 2024

Certificates for qualifications completed this summer will be available to collect from December. Certificates can only be retained for 12 months. If students are unable to collect them personally, they can authorise someone to collect them on your behalf using the permission form on the school website. Certificates are important documents as they may be required future employers or further education. Exam boards currently charge approximately £40 per board per season for duplicate copies so it can be costly to replace them.

If you wish to pay £2 via your school SCOPAY account we will send your certificates out by Royal Mail tracked post.
