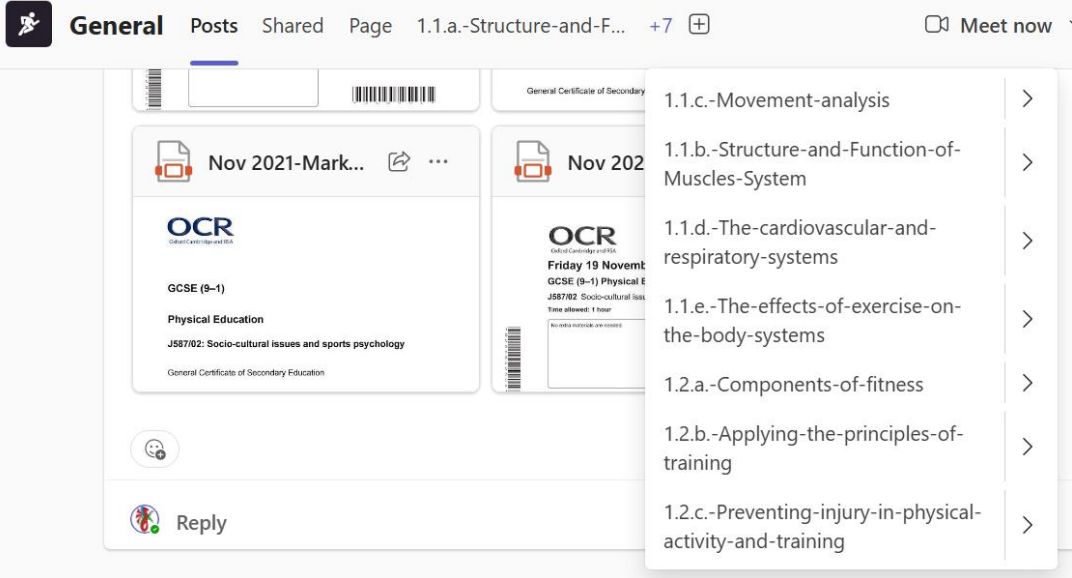
History	<u>Task</u> Year 10 History – Summer Transition Work Your first assessment in September will be a Germany Mock Exam. To prepare, you should spend time over the summer revising the Germany unit using effective revision techniques. Your task is to: • Revise all key content from the Germany topic. • Create mind maps, flashcards, or use other suitable revision methods (e.g. timelines, Cornell notes, retrieval practice quizzes, or revision grids). • Focus on key events, individuals, dates, causes, consequences and historical significance. • Regularly test yourself rather than simply re-reading your notes. • Aim to complete short, regular revision sessions throughout the summer to help improve long-term memory. Remember: The more effort you put into your transition work over the summer, the more confident and successful you will be in your Germany Mock Assessment in September.
