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### Code Of Respect - Players

Make sure you and everyone around you has a good time on and off the pitch

When playing football, I will:

- Always play my best for the benefit of the team
- Play fairly and be friendly
- Play by the rules and respect the referee
- Shake hands with the other team - win or lose
- Listen carefully to what my coach tells me
- Understand that a coach has to do what's best for the team
- Talk to someone I trust, or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.
- Encourage my team mates
- Respect facilities home & away

**I understand that if I do not follow the code, action may be taken by my club, the League, County FA or The FA.**

I may:

- Be asked to apologise to whoever I have upset
- Receive a formal warning
- Be dropped, substituted or suspended from training
- Be required to leave the club

In addition:

- My club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Respect
- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club

By setting a good example, we'll help build a supportive environment in which everyone can enjoy themselves.

Play your part and support The FA's Code of Respect:

I will:

- Have fun; it's what we're all here for!
- Celebrate effort and good play from both sides
- Always respect the Referee and coaches and encourage players to do the same
- Stay behind the touchline and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
- When players make mistakes, offer them encouragement to try again next time
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- I will make myself familiar with safeguarding practices & review guidance on **physical contact** (5.6) & **Acceptable Behaviours When Working With Young People** (5.7) documents on the safeguarding section of **EnglandFootball.com**

**I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my Club, County FA, league or The FA.**

I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have my membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents and/or issued a fine
