## Recycling:

Rubbish collectors also help look after our environment by collecting our **recycling**.

Recycling means making rubbish into something new. Instead of leaving rubbish in a big pile, things made from glass, paper, cardboard, plastic and metal can all be made into new things for us to use again.



Jewellery can be made from glass bottles.



This toy set is made from recycled plastic milk jugs!



We can help rubbish collectors by putting our rubbish in the correct bins.

If it can be recycled, we should put it in the recycling bin.
