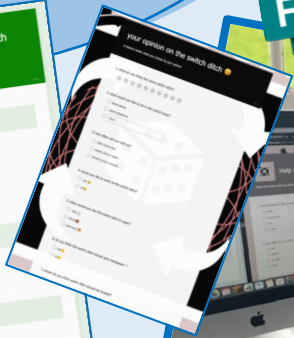
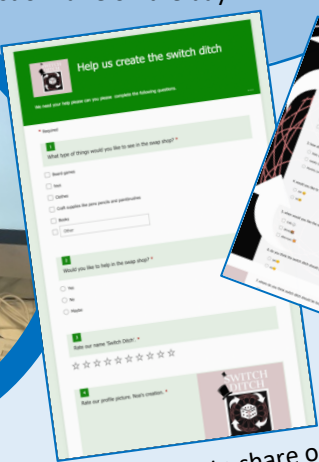


Key question: Do you believe others would visit the Switch Ditch?

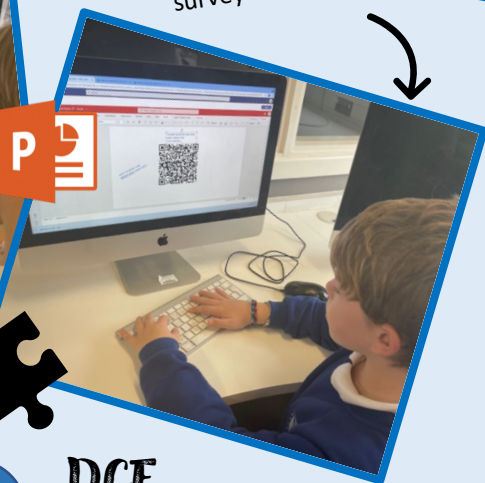
Before we launch the 'Switch Ditch' pupils were tasked with finding out if their idea would be successful. Pupils spent the day looking at the features of a good survey, and what questions would need to be included to find out if their idea would need adjusting! What days should we open? What would pupils like to swap? How often would pupils visit? Without this data, how would we truly know if the idea would be a success! Pupils developed their ICT skills further by sharing their completed surveys to the teams page for peer assessment and then, creating QR codes to pass on to other classes to scan and complete.
