- Visa to recognize qualification from three to six months.
- Opportunity of cost takeover for further education
- Direct employment with the full equivalence of professional qualifications
- In the case of partial recognition, residence permit for up to 18 months to complete the equivalence measures.
- Working as a nursing assistant during the recognition phase

SALARY OF A NURSE AND ASSISTANT NURSE IN GERMANY?

- Assistant nurse: 1700-2600 Euro
- Vocational training in nursing:
 1000 1200 Euro
- Nurse with Bachelor degree:
 2500 4900
- Highest: 5.000 Euro

WAY TO GERMANY FOR NURSES

Type of Visa for nursing specialists


Nursing staff from so-called third countries need a national visa and not a Schengen visa to enter Germany.

Two Type of Visa:

- Visa for working as an assistant
- Visa for recognition of professional qualifications

Work in Germany in 4 phases

Requirements



LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

Nursing staff from abroad who would like to work in Germany need at least B2 German language skills to practice their profession

Four courses in German:

A1 - A2 - B1 - B2

Each level: 80 till 200 Hours except B2 100 till 200 Teaching units

Language requirements:

Working Visa as an assistant: B2

Visa for recognition of qualification: A2

REGULATED PROFESSIONS

- Qualifications in the areas of health belong to regulated professions in Germany.
- Regulated professions are professions in which the activities are legally protected.
- All regulated professions require recognition of professional qualifications in Germany, regardless of the country of origin.

REQUIREMENTS: FOR RECOGNITION OF THE QUALIFICATION

- Three years of professional qualification.
- State-recognized or state-regulated qualification that enables access to the profession in the country of origin.
- Language exams at level B1 or B2
- Proof of completion of the beginner's an internship / preparatory service after completing medical school. (At least two years of professional experience).
- Health aptitude
- Proof of impunity

RECOGNITION OF QUALIFICATION

All applicants with a nursing degree from outside Germany, need to make Recognition of Qualification in Germany. There are three kinds of notification

Your qualification is equivalent:

State recognition as a nurse can be granted to you under the Nursing Act. No further action is necessary.

Equivalence can only be determined with further measures:

Your qualification can receive state recognition if you demonstrate an equivalent level of knowledge.

Your qualification is not equivalent

Notification with further measures

The Notification-Letter will include: Nursing Situation Option: Anpssungslehrgang or Kenntnisprüfung

knowledge test (Kenntnisprüfung)

The exam relates to the content and duration of the study. The test relates to the subjects nursing Practice and Special Areas of Law for nursing as well as to one of the subjects in which the competent authority has identified significant differences.

Adaptation course (Anpassungslehrgang)

- Duration one year.
- Working as an assistant nurse.
- Visiting courses.

Preparing for Recognition

- Obtaining the legally required documents.
- Legalization of original documents.
- Legalization of copies of certifications.
- Translations.
- Post.
- Learning German
- Submitting the documents to the regional council of the federal state in which one would like to work and live.
- The requirements are slightly different in each federal state, especially with regard to language skills and proof of the intention to work in this state.
- Aim of applying for recognition is to receive the so-called notification to be submitted to the embassy when applying for a visa.

VISA REQUIREMENT

Requirement for working visa as an assistant

- 1. Equivalent letter of Qualification
- 2. Job contract
- 3. Motivation letter
- 4. CV
- 5. Educational certificates
- 6. Language skills B2
- 7. Approval of the Federal Employment Agency
- 8. Financial Proof through the specified salary

Requirement for visa recognition of qualification:

- 1.Bescheid, Notification letter
- 2. Plan and registration for language and further training measures
- 3. Motivation letter
- 4. CV
- 5. German at least A2
- 6. Financial Proof ca. 11.350 Euro or commitment declaration

Budget



- For visa evaluation of qualification about 20.000 Euro.
- Opening account in Germany: 11.500 Euro
- Germany A1-B2: 2.000 3.000 Euro (4 levels)
- Costs for applying: 2.000 3.000 Euro
- Cash money for Germany: 2.000 Euro
- Extras: 600-1.600 Euro
- Budget for working visa as an assistant: between 4.000 6400 Euro.
- Opening account in Germany: 0 Euro
- German A1-B2: 2000 2500 Euro (4 levels)
- Costs for applying: 1.500 2.300 Euro
- Cash money for Germany: 2.000 Euro
